

**DEAR STUDENT,**

Clinical Practice Portfolio to be prepared within the scope of the NUR201 Internal Medicine Nursing course includes the relevant forms that will be used during the course evaluation process. According to the academic calendar, the NUR201 Internal Medicine Nursing Clinical Practice will begin on Monday, 29 September 2025, and end on Friday, 26 December 2025.

Throughout the clinical practice, students have undertaken duties in various units of the Near East University Hospital. At the end of the rotation, students are required to prepare a complete nursing care plan for **one of the patients** they cared for and submit it to the clinical/course instructor responsible for their group.

All data included in the care plan must be collected from a real patient; fictional or fabricated case information must not be used. The student portfolio must be submitted on the first Monday following the completion of the rotation (29.12.2025). Late submissions will not be accepted, the student will be considered unsuccessful, and the grade will be negatively affected.

Using assignments obtained from another student or from previous semesters constitutes plagiarism and will result in an automatic failure. Furthermore, unreadable, disorganized, or incomplete documents will negatively influence the evaluation grade.

The clinical practice grade will account for 20% of the total evaluation. The final practice grade will be determined by the average of:

- the evaluation score given by the clinical instructor,
- the end-of-term portfolio evaluation score.

Therefore, the practice grade you obtain during the clinical period will primarily depend on the evaluation made by the clinical instructor responsible for your group. In addition, the feedback provided by the clinical charge nurses throughout the internship will also serve as both supportive and determining components in the grading process.

## **GENERAL STRUCTURE OF THE PORTFOLIO**

End-of-Term Assignment Portfolio must consist of the following sections and be submitted as a single, complete portfolio:

1. **Cover Page**
2. **Table of Contents**
3. **Patient Data Collection and Care Plan Form**
4. **Clinical Daily Reports**
  - Mandatory for units where patient data could not be collected.
  - Reports should be written in daily format, arranged day by day.

### **Submission Method and Format of the Portfolio**

- Forms can be completed either by hand or electronically.
- The portfolio must be organized, legible, and complete.

### **Ethical Rules / Confidentiality Notice**

- Patient confidentiality must be maintained; no personal data (name, ID number, address, etc.) should be used, only the initials of the patient's name and surname.
- Only the initials of the patient's name and surname may be used.
- Patient data must be used solely for educational purposes and must not be shared with third parties.
- In case of a confidentiality breach, the assignment will be considered invalid.
