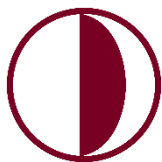

1. Preparing the environment: Ensuring that the necessary materials are ready and clean, maintaining the appropriate temperature and comfort	1	
2. Verifying the patient's identity and obtaining consent.	1	
3. Lock the casters and adjust the guardrails to the proper position	1	
4. Ensuring privacy (closing the curtains, using appropriate coverings)	1.5	
5. Hand washing / hand hygiene	0.5	
6. Establishing communication with the patient and providing information about the process.	1.5	
7, Putting on gloves.	1	
8, Assuming the proper position.	1	
9. Ensuring privacy in a manner appropriate to the position (square).	1	
10. Performing perineal care in the correct order while stating the Latin terms..	2	
11. Starting the wiping process from the far side first.	1.5

6. Name two conditions that carry a risk of developing oral health problems.
7. Name one cleaning tool used in oral care.
8. Name two situations that pose a risk to skin health.
9. Name two principles to follow when administering a bed bath.

• **Question Bank 2**

1. What does prolonged use of hydrogen peroxide cause in the papillae of the tongue?
2. What should be done to prevent corneal dryness in patients without a blinking reflex?
3. Why is it important for the water used in patient bathing to be lukewarm?
4. Does a bath increase or decrease muscle tone?
5. Which therapeutic bath is used in conditions causing rectal irritation, such as hemorrhoids?
6. Name two situations in which a back massage should not be performed.
7. Which part of the body is the hottest, most humid, and dirtiest?
8. List the steps of perineal care in women, using their Latin terms in order.
9. How should toenails and fingernails be trimmed?
